Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 5 Swimming Lessons – amended dates

Further to our previous letter regarding swimming lessons, please find an updated timetable for swimming due to a pool closure on the 8 February.

We have kept the details and reply slip from the original letter for your convenience. Obviously, if you have already returned the reply slip, it will not be necessary to do so again.

As part of their Physical Education programme, each Year 5 class will have swimming lessons once a week for 6 weeks at SplashPoint. We will be transporting the children to and from SplashPoint by minibus.

The lessons will be on a Thursday morning. See the table below for the dates for each class.

When completing the permission slip below, please indicate an approximate level of swimming ability. This will only be used as an initial guide as all children will be assessed by staff at SplashPoint.

Lessons are £4.50 each, totalling £27.00 for the course. Payment is voluntary and although we cannot insist on payment we would really appreciate your support which enables these lessons to go ahead. If you prefer to pay weekly and are unable to use the PMX system, please bring a cheque or cash to the office every Thursday morning in a named envelope. Please be aware that even if your child is absent from school the swimming costs still have to be paid by us and therefore no refund can be given and we would appreciate weekly contributions still being paid. Should anyone have difficulty with payments please do not hesitate to come and speak with Vanessa Neale, our Business Manager.

Please can I ask that **all permission slips are completed and returned** as soon as possible and initial or full payment is made before the first lesson.

Children will need to have appropriate swimwear which should be a one piece swimsuit for girls and short, not baggy trunks for boys. Goggles are advisable. SplashPoint has made the use of swimming caps compulsory for all school swimming lessons. These can be purchased from the school for £2 each.
